
## Welcome Taylor Miller!

SDI's for the January 2017 to June 2017 report period must be turned into Cathy Davis no later than August 1, 2017.

**As we start the new fiscal year**, please remember that we start counting people and households all over again in July. This means that you should be using brand new household distribution forms.

**Food safety is the top priority** at the Foodbank. Our staff receives training throughout the year to ensure that we keep all food safe. As a partner agency, you too must maintain and transport food safely. If you are transporting frozen or chill items, you **MUST** have coolers with either ice or freezer packs, or freezer blankets that completely cover all frozen or chill product.
