The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as food stamps, helps low-income people buy the food, such as fruits, vegetables and whole grains, they need for good health. The Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia and the Eastern Shore is proud to announce that we have been selected by Feeding America for a SNAP Outreach grant provided in part by Walmart. This grant will allow us to focus on reaching out to eligible people who are not currently participating in SNAP and share information about the nutrition benefits of SNAP to help them make an informed participation decision. We
