Melissa Carlton has been volunteering with Wave City Care in our Healthy Living Supplemental Food Distribution program since 2011. For the last four years, she has led the program and has done an amazing job. With her great management skills, she has restructured the program and been able to build the volunteer base from 4 to 30 individuals. Under her leadership, the outreach has expanded from a weekly program in Atlantis Apartments to adding bi-weekly delivery door-to-door for up to 30 seniors. Additionally, due to her strong leadership and management skills, we have been able to expand the program to Friendship Village, serving both single mothers and other residents, and also delivering to the seniors. Melissa also ensures that the seniors receive a nice card with their food and has the team give them reminder calls the day before. Melissa goes out of her way to keep both the volunteers and the residents encouraged and happy. She's an exceptional team lead and has a huge heart for those in need.
