



13th Annual Statewide Legal Food Frenzy

RULES

The following explains the rules for counting non-perishable food and financial contributions for Legal Food Frenzy for the Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia and the Eastern Shore

- The contest runs from April 15 – April 26, 2019. You may not count any money or food collected before or after the competition.
- Each dollar contributed will count as **four pounds** of food.
- Contributions of money are tax-deductible and are very welcome.
 - Checks should be made payable to **The Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia and the Eastern Shore (Foodbank SEVA)**.
 - You may donate online by going to our website, foodbankonline.org.
- Food items will be weighed and the results tabulated in pounds.
- Awards will be based on total pounds divided by the number of employees. When counting the number of employees, count each person working at the firm, regardless of position.
- All food and fund donations must be turned in to Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia and the Eastern Shore the week of April 29 – May 3, 2019, in order to be counted towards the competition.
- Your firm will receive a 25% bonus of tabulated pounds for delivering all food and monetary contributions to the Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia and the Eastern Shore at 800 Tidewater Drive, Norfolk, VA 23504.
- Ways to receive additional bonus points:
 - 100 points for submitting a 'wear orange' photo for 2018 Hunger Action Month
 - 100 points for registering by March 31, 2019
 - 500 points for signing up as an office to volunteer by April 26 (may be scheduled for a later date)
 - 1,000(!) points for a referring a new firm to the competition
 - *The 'new' firm must have not competed in 2018 and must recognize the 'referring' firm on its 2019 registration*
- **Firms and Organizations with multiple locations:** Offices located within another food bank's service area will compete independently at the state level. Ex. A firm's office in Virginia Beach will compete against their office in Richmond.
