# HOW TO SAFELY RECEIVE FOOD FROM THE FOODBANK

## Do's

- ✓ Once you have pulled up to the loading station, stay in your vehicle AT ALL TIMES!
- ✓ If you are a walk-up, please remain 6ft apart and follow social distance guidelines
- ✓ Please come with your TRUNK EMPTY. If you need to make room in your trunk for product, please do so before you pull up to the front.
- ✓ Put your car completely in park at each stopping point, and end all phone calls

## Dont's

- ✗ Show up with a cluttered car. You will have to pull off to the side and load your own car if the trunk is not clear.
- ✗ Get out of the vehicle
- ✗ Continue to be on the phone once you have pulled up to the loading station.
- ✗ Continue to have the car in drive while volunteers are loading your vehicle.
