## Foodbank to Hold Drive-Thru Food Pantry for up to 1,000 Households at Chesapeake Social Services

Norfolk, VA – April 27, 2023 – As inflation continues to put pressure on food-insecure families, the Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia will hold a drive-thru food distribution at the Chesapeake Social Services parking lot, located at 100 Outlaw Street, on Saturday, May 6 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Funded by the City of Chesapeake, it is open to all city residents on a first come, first serve basis who will receive approximately 45 pounds of fresh produce, protein, and shelf-stable foods.
