This initiative brought together businesses and individuals who collected food, raised funds, and volunteered their time, resulting in a making significant impact on eliminating hunger in our region.

A staggering \$65,295.57 was raised, alongside an impressive donation of 4,440 pounds of food. This achievement translates to a total of 93,146 meals provided to those in need.
